Centuries of history transpired in this home built on land in an area which was settled in the early 1630s. Paula breathes life into the genealogical names of those who lived there by setting them against the backdrop of major events of their times. Families and neighbors imprinted by Indian wars, a War for Independence and the War of 1812, along with all the social and economic shifts which expanded and contracted their community over the centuries. Pennsbury Manor is a recreated estate used by William Penn while acting as Proprietor for the Colony of Pennsylvania, 1683-1701. Consider touring this peaceful historic site before heading home.
